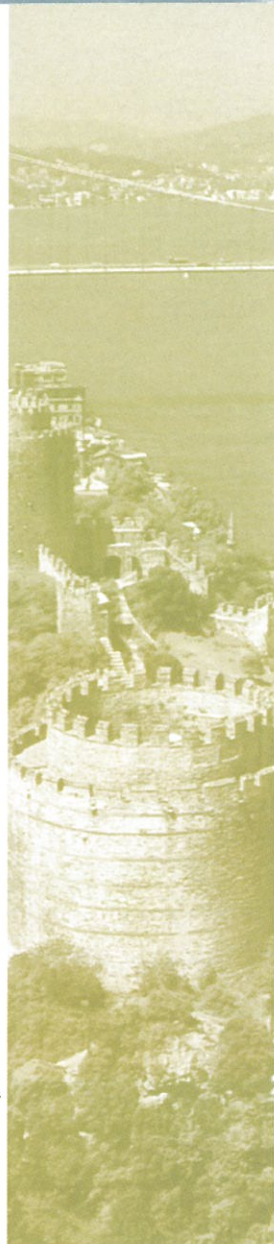

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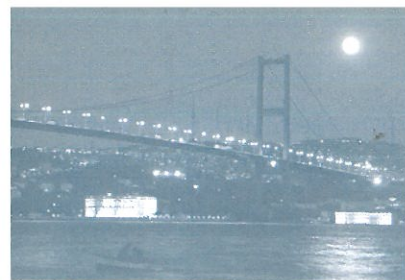

The organizers of the 17th APCDC invite you to attend the congress and participate in the scientific deliberations.

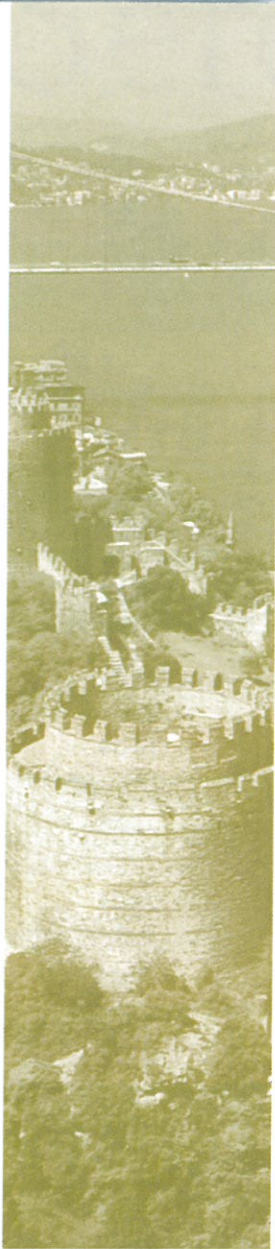

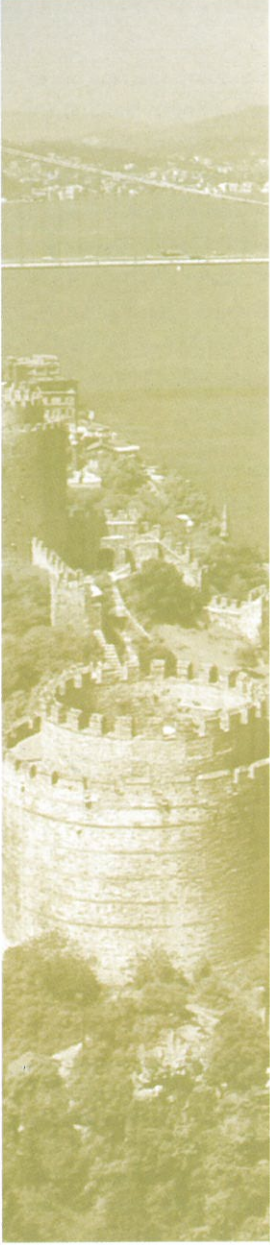




# ISTANBUL CITY MAP

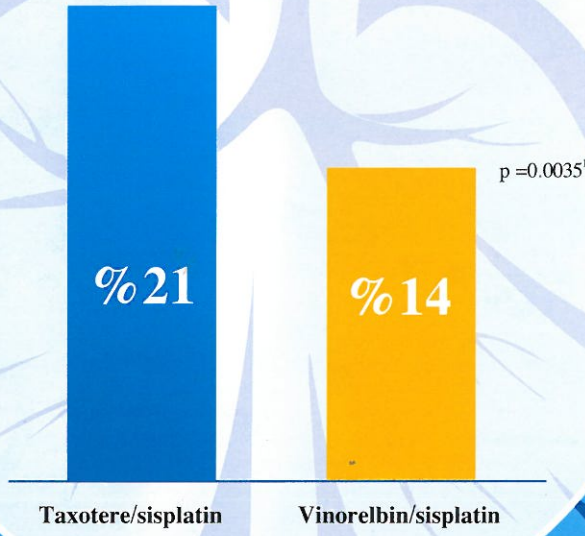

Hipersensitivite reaksiyonları, genellikle dosetaksel infüzyonunun başlamasından sonra dakikalar içinde ortaya çıkmış ve genellikle hafif ve orta şiddette olmuştur. Hipotansiyon ve/veya bronkospazm ile karakterize olan ağır reaksiyonlar nadirdir ve infüzyonun kesilmesi ve uygun tedaviyle düzelmiştir. Reversibl deri reaksiyonları gözlemlenmiş ve genellikle hafif ve orta şiddette olmuştur. Radyasyon hatırlama fenomeni nadiren bildirilmiştir. **İlaç etkileşimleri ve diğer etkileşimler:** Ketokonazol, siklosporin, terfenadin, eritromisin ve toleandomisin gibi ilaçlar ile etkileşim görülebilir. 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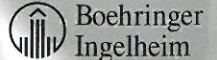
